376 TO RECEIVE A REPORT FROM THE CLERK

The clerk reported back on the annual health & safety inspection and will let councillors have a copy of the report.

378 CITY FIBRES PLANS FOR INSTALLING FIBRE OPTIC CABLE IN THE GREEN

Mr Spencer has met with City Fibre who will need to dig trenches. They will try to keep them as close to the edges as possible. Mr Spencer has recommended that they complete School Lane before the end of August and the school reopens.

379 POT HOLE REPAIRS ON THE ACCESS ROAD TO THE EAST OF JUBILEE ROAD

Two quotes have been received, members agreed to the quote from Sherwood Brothers, however it will need to wait until a house on that road is connected to mains drains.

380 PLANS FOR THE PARKING AREA NORTH OF THE COPSE IN LITTLEWICK GREEN

Recommendation has been made to change the plastic matting to concrete grass pavers. Trial holes will need to be dug before any decisions are made to see whether the previous contractor fitted the correct membranes.

381 COMMUNITY SPEEDWATCH

Mr Ford updated members on the community speedwatch in White Waltham. There are three people signed up including Mr Ford and Mr Graves. Mr Ford is hoping to get everything ready for September when the schools go back.

Littlewick ward councillors expressed an interest in trialling speedwatch around the green.

382 BIODIVERSITY POLICY ACTION PLAN

It was agreed as part of the parish councils environment strategy that the council would develop a policy using the SLCC's model action plan. The clerk will start the work and then members add details in for each ward.

383 BEE SQUARED PROJECT

The clerk put forward a plan to plant more wildflowers for bees and butterflies. The parish council will gift a packet of seeds, enough for a square metre, of bee friendly wildflowers for any resident who would like to take part.
