499 TO DISCUSS THE LUNCH CLUB

The lunch club has been in deficit for the last few years. The number of White Waltham parish residents has reduced over the years and there are only 5 out of a total of 30 attendees. It was agreed that for financial reasons, staffing, and because the parish council couldn't meet their health & safety obligations that the lunch club will close.

500 TO APPROVE A REDUCTION IN HIRE COST FOR WHITE WALTHAM CHURCH, LITTLE LAMBS GROUP

As the playgroup is for the local community, members agreed a reduction in the cost of hall hire. To be reviewed in one years' time.

501 CLEANING OF THE PATH BETWEEN WOODLANDS PARK & WHITE WALTHAM

It was agreed to get separate quotes for the clearing up to the White Waltham sign opposite the village centre for the White Waltham ward and from the sign up to Willant Close for Woodlands park ward.

Members discussed how the CIL money from the Grove Park development could be used within White Waltham. The clerk was asked to find information on the electronic speed signs.
